How are registration fees calculated?

Once a year during the off season the Pascoe Vale Junior Committee review the clubs running costs and calculates the registration fees for the following season. In setting registration fees the club aims to provide value for money and cover its operating costs, with the smallest of margins built in for incidentals such as increases in utilities and council charges, unexpected maintenance and repairs, etc.

The club also relies on fundraising and sponsorship as a source of revenue, which contributes towards capital works at the club as well as subsidises other player and team costs. The club does not set out to make a profit or to profit from player fees!

What are the junior registration fees for 2009?

We are pleased to advise that for season 2009 player registration fees for all new and existing junior players (U11 to U18) remains the same as in 2008.

The club has also introduced two new registration fee categories to cover all sub-junior players (U5 to U10) playing Small Sided Games and the "Train on Player" registration fee for junior players that train only and do not participate in competition.

Sub-Junior Small Sided Game (U5 to U10)	: \$195.00
Juniors (U11 to U18)	: \$395.00
Junior Train On Player (U11 to U18)	: \$295.00

What every player gets for their money?

The club aims to set a single standard and portray a professional appearance with its equipment and uniforms. All players regardless of their age group receive the following:

- Playing Top
- Playing Shorts
- Playing Socks
- Track Suit Top*
- Track Suit Pants*
- Equipment Bag*
- Award Trophy
- Training & Tuition twice/week from Feb – Sept.
- FFV Player Registration & Insurance

*Track tops, pants and equipment bags are provided to all NEW players. It is club policy that all existing registered players have these particular items replaced only after every 2nd season at no extra cost, however these can be purchased from the club should they be required beforehand.

Registration fees also cover:

- Team registration with FFV & FFA (\$210 per team except for SSG)
- Moreland City Council charges
- Referees fees for every home game
- Purchase of club training equipment
- Coaches education (Please note that our junior coaches do not currently get paid a wage)
- Statutory licences (e.g. supply of food and drink, first aid)
- Purchase of safety/first aid equipment
- Maintenance of facilities
- Utilities (electricity, telephones, line marking of grounds, upgrading and repairs of lights)
- Other services – printing, postage, internet provider, etc, etc.
